Contact:

1. General

All equipment must be on location and set up (1) hour before sound check. All equipment must be professional grade free from any operational defects. Lights and sound must be powered adequately from separate services. Provided Engineer and Crew must have expert knowledge of equipment in use.

2. **P.A.**

When provided by purchaser, P.A. shall be of good quality and appropriately powered for the event. System will be professionally setup, tuned, ringed out and timed by (1)hour before sound check. Up to 150 people in a smaller venue, a 2 way system may be utilized, i.e. minimum (2) QSC K15 w/ (2)KW 181 or similar. 150 people or more in a large venue, 3-4 Way Line Array with Subs(d&b, L'acoustic, Meyers, VTEC or similar). System sized appropriately for venue so all areas have equal coverage with no distortion up to 100db.

3. **F.O.H**

Minimum 24 channel digital console with dynamics on every channel and FX, i.e. Yamaha CL/QL, Midas M32/PRO. Provided Engineer and Crew must have expert knowledge of equipment in use, *esp. the console*. General reverb with appropriate delay effects on Vox and band

3. *Monitors*

- 1 (2) wedges at DSC. Powered 15" 2-way w/appropriate power(Meyers, d&b, L'acoustic)
- 2. (8)wedges total needed. 6 mixes. See plot.

4. Stage

Minimum of 32' wide x 20' deep. Drum riser 8'x6' minimum. Access stairs to main stage must be provided.

- (7) Music Stands w/lights.
- (4) Power Quad Boxes(minimum) see plot.

5 **Backing Tracks**

Backing/Supportive tracks may be used if determined to be needed by venue and performer, i.e. missing and or limited live instrumentation. Provided tracks are stereo files, track on RIGHT and musician cue/click LEFT. When tracks are used venue and performers will determine if and how IEM's will be implemented.

6. Lighting

Lighting shall be of professional quality with coverage of entire performance area. General front/side wash with backlight and backlight special DSC. Lighting color and looks to suit music at operators discretion. If spot operator is not provided, general down stage wash required.


