Presenter will provide all equipment and full backline, including drum kit, piano or keyboard, bass and guitar amps, monitors, microphones, and music stands with lights. Specific requests as follows:

BACKLINE

All backline equipment, microphones, speakers, monitors, cable, PA, etc must be in excellent working order. All should be set up, cabled, and patched by the time the artist arrives according to standard stage plot & input list attached.

• SOUND/MUSICAL EQUIPMENT SUPPLIED BY PRESENTER:

Presenter will provide a professional sound system, capable of providing clear sound throughout the venue's auditorium, as well as microphones, reverberation and monitors. Artist may or may not bring a sound engineer. Regardless, presenter will also provide a professional, clean, & sober engineer familiar with venue and sound system prepared to operate sound system for the full sound check and performance. Sound engineer must be the same person for any and all sound checks, rehearsals, and performances. Equipment and levels cannot be changed or re-arranged prior to the performance once the Artist completes sound check.

VIDEO CONTENT:

This performance includes video content that is integral to the show. Content only contains still images. Please advise video specs and capabilities with Production Manager when show is advanced.

• LIGHTING DESIGN:

Presenter to provide general stage lighting and two (2) spotlights. One light at the piano is required as well. Presenter will provide a professional, clean, & sober lighting operator familiar with venue and light plot to operate lighting system for the full sound check and performance. Sound engineer must be the same person for any and all sound checks, rehearsals, and performances. Production Manager, and/or Artist will discuss lighting cues and colors upon arrival at the venue.

DRESSING ROOMS / SECURITY / CATERING:

- Presenter will provide a minimum of (4) dressing rooms during Artist's entire performance. Dressing rooms shall have a mirror with appropriate lighting, several electrical outlets, and comfortable seating. Each dressing room shall have a private, clean bathroom within or nearby. Dressing room must remain locked during performances.
- Presenter will guarantee proper security to all musicians, instruments and other personal property before, during and after the performance(s).
- The following should be supplied for Artist and musicians:
 - Clothing Steamer
 - o Non-carbonated spring/distilled bottled water
 - o Pellegrino Soda Water
 - Assorted Herbal teas and hot water
 - Coffee (Regular & Decaf) and fresh milk, soy milk, sugar, sweeteners

- Hot meals TBD available no later than 90 minutes before performance start time for Artist and musicians. NO FAST FOOD under any circumstance. Chicken, seafood, and vegan options required, with salad and/or vegetables. No red meat. Additionally, please note that there is one PESCETARIAN and one NUT-ALLERGIC VEGAN in the group.

The name/likeness of Artist may not be used or associated, either directly or indirectly, with any product or service without Artist's prior consent. Interviews will be granted to individuals representing major print or electronic media wherever possible with prior approval of Artist. All requests for interviews shall be submitted to Artist in advance. Interviews cannot be guaranteed. Artist retains the right to grant any interviews for print or electronic media in conjunction with the performance. Presenter agrees that it will not commit Artist to any personal interviews or promotional appearance without the prior consent of the Artist.

RECORDING / PHOTOGRAPHY:

No audio recordings, video recordings or radio broadcasts of the performance permitted without prior approval. Artist has the right to request an audio and/or video recording be made of the performance for archival purposes, at no cost to the Artist. There will be no flash photography permitted during the performance.

MISCELLANEOUS:

Artist has 100% control of the performance. All terms and conditions of this rider are specifically accepted by Presenter unless waived by Artist.

MERCHANDISE:

Artist retains 100% of merchandise/CD sales. Venue supplies table and merchandiser.
